Dear Steel Center students, families, and partners,

I continue to wish you well and good health as we continue through the school year. I am writing to provide you with some updates concerning our Covid-19 operations and mitigation efforts as well as some other important information and announcements.

Covid-19 Operations:

- Steel Center continues to operate under the hybrid instructional model with some students continuing to choose 100% remote learning. Our schedule for in-person learning remains: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday with remote learning on Wednesday for all students.
- Within the in-person learning framework, some students remain two days per week and as we announced last month, starting this week some students have begun increasing the days that they attend Steel Center.
- Increasing students' in-person learning days has been based on changes in member district instructional models and/or requests from our member districts. Our Health and Safety/Instructional plan was designed to be dynamic and adjust to changes within our member school districts' plans. We will continue to support and work cooperatively with your school districts regarding adjustments to instructional models.
- If students and families have questions regarding in-person learning days as well as transportation, be sure to reach out to your high school administration as well as Steel Center's main office. It is our goal to keep communications clear and consistent, and given the nature of Covid-19 operations it can be helpful to check with both systems when needed.
