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Dear Steel Center Family:

My name is Tanya Busch and I am the teacher for the Medical Professions Program. I have been teaching at Steel Center for 20 years. I am a Registered Nurse with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. My industry experience comes from working in a hospital setting, home health care, and an outpatient surgical setting.

Medical Professions is a program designed to prepare individuals for entry-level employment in a health related occupation. The core curriculum consists of introduction to health careers, basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, infection control, legal and ethical aspects of health care, as well as clinical skills. Instruction in Phlebotomy and Pharmacy Technology may be offered following the first year if the student maintains a C average or better.

Students are expected to present themselves in a professional manner at all times. With that in mind, these are the <u>basic requirements</u> for the class:

- 1st yr. students Dark Gray (graphite, pewter) Scrubs
- May wear white, black, gray long sleeve jersey or lab coat under/over scrubs
- Phlebotomy & Pharm Tech students may wear color/print scrubs of choice
- White or Black tennis or nursing shoes for all students
- Uniforms are required for class beginning on Monday, September 15th
- 2nd/3rd yr. \$120 for Phlebotomy and \$120 for Pharmacy Technician exams
- \$15 for CPR Certification
- Pen/pencil, notebook, and binder
- Adherence to all school wide and classroom rules.
