In this automotive service excellence certified program, students will use the latest curriculum from ASE, I-CAR, CCC ONE, and NATEF to acquire the set of skills to succeed in this rewarding trade.

Your student will not only learn this trade but will acquire the necessary skills and responsibilities to work in any trade. The students of Collision Repair are directly responsible for maintaining weekly work logs, time cards, and calls off procedures when absent from school. All students will get a chance to explore customer service and management opportunities throughout the school year. This will ultimately help prepare your student for a rewarding career anywhere.

Suggested items required for this course

- Note book with lined paper (hard back binders are provided for handouts.)
- Extra pencils and pens (I will give one of each out every 9 weeks)
- Sharpe black marker (I will provide one if needed)
- Work pants - Black work pants **No Jeans**
- Work shirt – Black button down
- Work boots – Steel toe leather no slip sole
- Safety glasses – One pair will be provided. You student will be allowed to purchase another pair if lost.
- Eye glass wearers- must have side shields or wear safety glasses on top of eye glasses

Tools required for this class

- ¼ inch socket set- this set should include Metric and standard socket, ratchet, and extensions.
- Screw driver set- Phillips and standard
 - All other specialty and pneumatic tools will be provided.
 - Before you buy any tools make sure to check sears or harbor freight. They have sets that are very affordable. If your students would like to bring more of their tools in that is also ok. Please check with Mr. Canavan first.

If a student can't afford a set of tools they can use the schools tools until they can afford their own set.

It will be the responsibility of your student to make sure that all of their tools, work cloths, and personal belongings be locked in their lockers at the end of each day.
