Dear Steel Center Family:

My name is Tanya Busch and I am the teacher for the Medical Professions Program. I have been teaching at Steel Center for 18 years. I am a Registered Nurse with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. My industry experience comes from working in a hospital setting, home health care, and an outpatient surgical setting.

Medical Professions is a program designed to prepare individuals for entry-level employment in a health related occupation. The core curriculum consists of introduction to health careers, basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, infection control, legal and ethical aspects of health care, as well as clinical skills. Instruction in Phlebotomy and Pharmacy Technology may be offered following the first year as long as the student maintains a C average or better.

Students are expected to present themselves in a professional manner at all times. With that in mind, these are the <u>basic requirements</u> for the class:

- 1st yr. students Dark Gray (graphite, pewter) Scrubs
- Phlebotomy & Pharm Tech students may wear color/print scrubs of choice
- May wear white, black, gray long sleeve jersey or lab coat under/over scrubs
- White or Black tennis or nursing shoes
- Scrubs may be purchased anywhere, but if purchasing from Model, please place order by <u>August 1st</u>.
- <u>Uniforms are required for class beginning on Tuesday, September 5th.</u>
- 2nd/3rd yr. \$117 for Phlebotomy and \$117 for Pharmacy Technician exams
- Pen/pencil, notebook, and binder
- Adherence to all school wide and classroom rules.
