## THE CHILL PROJECT

In our efforts to provide a full range of support for Steel Center students, we are very happy to be partners with the Allegheny Health Network/Jefferson Hospital's "*Chill Project*". Currently operating within the Baldwin-Whitehall, South Park, and West Jefferson Hills School Districts, the *Chill Project* will offer both preventative and targeted supports and services for our school community. Preventative supports will be provided by our Behavioral Health School Educator: Ms. Roz Knapp. Ms. Knapp will be providing preventive services, creating a toolbox of skills and a common skill-based language that can increase resiliency, mindful awareness and decrease maladaptive behaviors. She will also be facilitating the "*Chill Room*" which offers formalized lessons and walk-in appointments. The targeted supports of the *Chill Project* will be provided by the yet-to-be named school-based outpatient Behavioral Health Therapist whose office will be located in our Student Services department. We are proud to be able to offer this new support system to our students and families.
